**Life Safety:** Class "E" fire alarm; the building is fully sprinklered;

**Elevators:** 3 newly modernized passenger elevators; 1 newly modernized freight elevator

**Transportation Access:** One block to 6 train (one stop to Grand Central Terminal and shuttle to Times Square); two blocks to E (convenient access to Port Authority and Penn Station) and two blocks to M train.

**Parking:** Two public parking garages on 51st Street between Third and Lexington Avenues.
